### **Public Works/Planning & Development**

Councillor Boyd reported that most of the patch paving has been completed.

Town Manager, Leonard Hann gave an update on the wells. The mulching around the well sites is completed. The wells are currently being tested and there are no leaks reported. There are some issues with one well that must be addressed and fixed. Diagnostic tests have been completed to test the chlorine and make sure everything is running correctly.

#### **Beautification**

Councillor Dawson reported that it is nice to see a picnic bench and seat on the green space formerly used as a garage on Kippens Road. Town Manager reported that work is being planned for the electronic sign as it appears some internal cards need replaced. Councillor Dawson reported that some initial efforts have been made with two pieces of policy which will be shared through a workshop process with council.

## Mayor's Report

Mayor D. Brake-Patten thanked the inmates at the penitentiary for their work on the picnic tables. Mayor stated that the position of Mayor and Councillor is a volunteer position and no abuse will be taken from residents, council members or staff and hopefully none will be given as well. Mayor has been in this position for almost two years and it has been a very tumultuous two years. Council needs to get control of the situation. Mayor has no intentions of resigning but is here to lead the people and do the right thing for the best interest of all the people. If anyone wants a voice they are encouraged to run in the next election. If anyone is on council for their own benefit they are encouraged to move on.
