- 3.** Second baseball field rehabilitation completed.

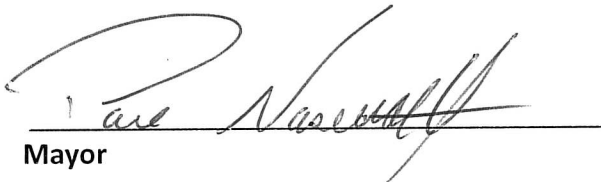
Council had a general discussion on the off-road vehicles on the main road and side roads in Kippens and the poor cell phone service in Kippens.
