#### **CAO/Manager Report**

- New Town Website has been launched and is now live.
- A subscription service is available to residents (through the website) so that they may be kept up to date. He encourages use of the website rather than Social Media as it is not monitored by the Town.

- Overnight Parking Ban comes into effect on Monday, Dec 15, 2025. Parking on public streets is not permitted during the hours of 1 a.m to 7 a.m. Residents are also asked that when there is significant snowfall, to allow time for maintenance crews to clear the roads.
- Fire Department Boot Drive will take place on December 20, 2025. Please exercise caution as members will be on Kippens Highway.
