

Spring Clean Up 2026

Spring Clean-Up is the special collection of general household items that are too bulky for normal collection. Residents are to have all items out to the curb by **Monday May 25th** at 7:00am. Once an area has been completed, it will **not be** collected again. All items must be placed near the curbside / roadside in separate piles.

Items for pickup **must** be bagged or bound (**no more than 40lbs**) as large piles of small debris will not be collected unless it is contained. **Maximum length for any item is 4 feet (48 inches)**. Items must still follow Sort It Western Guidelines using clear or blue bags.

Acceptable

Max weight 40 pounds
Max length – 4 feet

Bulk&Household

- Household Furniture: Sofas, Chairs, Dressers,
- Table & Chairs
- Mattress &Box Springs
- Lawn Furniture
- Children’s Toys, Bicycles/Tricycles
- Broken Glass (Safely packaged)
- Light Fixtures, Fans: Floor & Ceiling
- Textiles – (Clothing or Bedding)
- Small Appliances

Metals

Metal items must be in a separate pile.

- Appliances
- Small auto parts
- BBQ

Unacceptable

- Compostable Materials: Grass, Branches, Leaves, Lumber, Pallets, Trees
- Automotive Parts exceeding 40 lbs
- Sled bodies / Sleds / ATV Frames / Side by Side Frames
- Construction / Renovation Material including drywall, roof shingles, bricks, cement or concrete, windows, doors, etc
- Fire Extinguishers, Welding Tanks, Air Tank or any other Pressurized Tank.
- Propane Tanks
- Vehicle Batteries
- Tires
- Gas Cans
- Oil Tanks
- Medical Waste
- Liquid Waste
- Hazardous, Explosive or Toxic Waste
- Paint products (i.e. all household paint products and containers, paint aerosols of all types and automotive, craft and industrial paint)
- Electronic Waste (E-Waste) (i.e. display devices such as TVs and monitors, desktop printers and scanners, computers, cellular and non-cellular telephones, audio and video game systems.

**All items must be bagged or contained – No exceptions –
Any items not contained will not be picked up.**
